

AZ Ice Families:

Please be advised of the updated AZ Ice Arcadia safety guidelines and requirements noted below as we move into the next phase of reopening of protocol.

We have, and continue to, ask our AZ Ice Families to assist us in following all guidelines put forth by AZ Ice Arcadia, Governor Ducey, ADHS and the CDC.

Effective August 10, 2020:

**WE WILL BE TAKING A NO TOUCH TEMPERATURE ON EVERYONE ENTERING THE BUILDING! If that shows 100 degrees or higher you will not be admitted to the building – NO EXCEPTIONS!**

- All employees, participants and parents **must wear a mask/face covering at all times off-ice** in the facility. There will be **NO EXCEPTIONS** (unless under age 6) to this policy. Face coverings **MUST** be worn properly, covering nose AND mouth.
- Locker rooms will be OPEN! However, locker room space is limited as only two lockers will be available per session. Players are **HIGHLY encouraged** to arrive at least partially dressed. Parents/ guardians will not be permitted in locker rooms. Players needing assistance getting dressed should arrive partially dressed and use front benches to get skates on. **Dressing/ undressing in the lobby is PROHIBITED.**
- At this time, we will not be allowing spectators in the building – however youth players will be allowed one parent/ guardian to be present in the building (mask required at all times). For older players, we recommend that parents not enter the arena at all.
- Spectators can watch programming Live or On Demand using the [Live Barn App](#).
- Bring your own pre-filled water bottle – no water fountains/no sharing. Any water bottles left in the building will be thrown in the trash. No lost and found will be kept.
- Limit time spent in the facility that is outside of scheduled ice slot. Arrive no sooner than 20 minutes prior to your scheduled session and leave promptly at its conclusion. Players **MUST** exit the building within 15 minutes following their session.
- Enter and Exit the rink through the properly designated doors only.
- Participation by online registration in advance only.

**We strongly encourage all AZ Ice Family members to practice social distancing, avoid congregating in large groups (both inside and outside the building) and practice good hygiene by frequently washing hands, avoiding high touch surfaces and using hand sanitizer.**

*Participants/spectators who are currently sick, recently sick, live in a home with someone sick, symptomatic or high-risk/vulnerable to illness are asked to avoid the rinks. We are also asking that you self-report any of these situations to the rink promptly so we can take the appropriate steps necessary to protect the health and safety of everyone!*

We ask that you follow all arena policies including posted signage and any verbal instructions from AZ Ice Arcadia staff.

The situation continues to evolve, and we appreciate your continued cooperation.
